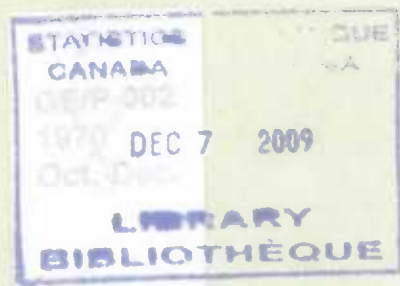

GLOSSARY OF PRINCIPAL TERMS USED

DEPARTMENTAL SERVICES: Also known as General Fund activities. This comprises the activities carried on by provincial governments as reflected in their Estimates and in addition, expenditures on employment by special or administrative funds.

PROVINCIAL INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION: These are educational institutions at the university level which are under the control of the provincial government, but which are not administered under departmental authority.

PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT ENTERPRISES: These produce goods and services for sale on the open market at a price normally set to recover costs.

SALARY EARNERS: Employees in receipt of a salary based on monthly or annual rates of pay. These employees may be of a continuing, term, seasonal, sessional or part-time nature.

WAGE EARNERS: Employees in receipt of a wage based on hourly, daily or weekly rates of pay.

FULL-TIME WAGE EARNERS: Employees who occupy a continuing full-time position.

OTHER WAGE EARNERS: Employees who do not occupy a continuing full-time position. Examples are: seasonal, part-time and casual wage earners.

NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES: Represents the number of persons on the payroll for the last pay period reported in each month.

GROSS PAYROLLS: Payrolls reported are the gross payrolls of all persons paid during the month whether they were on strength at the end of the month or not. They include retroactive pay, salary adjustments and over-time payments.

NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series is given, together with other background detail, in the report for April - June 1970.

Data of the Departmental Services, Government Enterprises, and Workmen's Compensation Board of the Province of British Columbia are not available for inclusion in this publication. Data for the Institutions of Higher Education in that province are included.

The number of employees relates to employment on the last day of the month or at the end of the final pay period of the month. The payrolls represent all monies paid to employees during the period before any deductions for income tax etc. Retroactive and overtime payments are included in the month the payments are made.

The gross payrolls of the provincial government employees (available for inclusion in this report) for the fourth quarter of 1970 amounted to \$648.5 million, a slight increase of 0.8 per cent over the \$643.1 million reported for the previous quarter of July-September 1970 and a 14.1 per cent increase over the \$568.1 million for the same period in 1969. These increases are the result of (1) additional pay periods for those employees who are paid on a bi-weekly or weekly basis. (2) Increases in salaries and other remunerations in departmental services and government enterprises plus the lump sum retroactive adjustments that accompanied these increases.

The number of employees reported for the last pay period of December 1970 was 357,284 a decrease of 3.3 per cent from the 369,450 employees reported for the same period in September 1970 and a 5.8 per cent increase over the 337,682 employees reported for the last pay period in December 1969. The decrease in the number of employees from the previous quarter is the result of normal seasonal reductions of part-time employees in both the salary and wage earning categories.

The cumulative payrolls for provincial government employees (included in this report) for the period January to the last pay period in December 1970 amounted to \$2,430.7 million. Employees in departmental services were paid \$1,417.8 million (58.3%) while those of institutions of higher education, provincial government enterprises, and workmen's compensation boards respectively received \$314.1 million (12.9%), \$671.2 million (27.6%), \$27.6 million (1.2%).

Due to unavoidable delays in reporting, estimates have been used for the government of the Northwest Territories. Revised totals will be published in the next quarterly report.

Comparability Between Numbers and Earnings

The user of these statistics is advised to avoid making direct comparison between the numbers of employees reported and the gross payrolls reported, the reason for this being that the numbers of employees relate to the last day of the month wherever possible and otherwise to the final pay period of the month. Since in certain categories, especially casual employment, considerable fluctuations in numbers employed occur during a month, it will be seen that a comparison between the payrolls of all persons employed during the month and the number on strength at the end of the month would, in many cases, not be valid.
